**SITE 1 VADOSE ZONE SOILS
FORMER MARINE CORPS AIR STATION EL TORO**

The Department of the Navy (Navy) has issued an Action Memorandum for a TCRA to address potential explosive safety hazards on private property adjacent to the Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Training Range as well as addressing naphthalene-impacted soil on the EOD Training Range on the former MCAS El Toro, Irvine, California. The Navy developed the selected Action Memorandum alternatives in coordination with regulatory agency members of the Base Realignment and Closure Cleanup Team during preparation of the Revised Draft Final Vadose Zone Feasibility Study Report IRP Site 1 EOD Training Range. This cleanup will be the final action for the adjacent private property achieving unrestricted reuse and an interim action for the EOD Training Range (which the Federal Government will retain ownership). The TCRA is anticipated to begin in December 2016.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD – The Navy invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the Action Memorandum during a 30-day Public Comment Period, from November 1 to November 30, 2016.
