You can make a difference! Get involved with the environmental cleanup of the former MCAS Tustin as a member of the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB).

What is a RAB?

The Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Tustin RAB was established in 1994 to involve the local community in the environmental cleanup decision making process. The RAB is an advisory body designated to act as a focal point for exchanging information and concerns between the Navy and the local community regarding environmental issues.

The RAB is intended to bring together community members who reflect the diverse interests within the local community. The RAB primarily consists of community members, but also includes representatives from the Navy, United States and California Environmental Protection Agencies, and City of Tustin staff. This structuring of the RAB allows two-way flow of information, concerns, and needs between the affected community, the Navy, and regulatory agencies.

RAB members are expected to meet regularly to review and comment on technical documents and plans relating to environmental studies and cleanup activities at the former station. Understanding of the cleanup process and environmental issues is gained through presentations from, and interaction with, the key participants. The Navy provides technical information and administrative support for RAB meetings. Members serve as liaisons with the community members and groups. All RAB meetings are open to the public.

How to Become a RAB Member

Community members interested in finding out more about the RAB are encouraged to attend RAB meetings typically held at the Senior Center, 200 South 'C' Street, in Old Town Tustin. At the meetings, you will hear an update on the status of base clean-up activities and selected presentations on current projects.

The RAB meetings are held bi-annually from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. RAB meeting dates are posted at: www.bracpmo.navy.mil. If you have questions about the RAB, please call Don Zweifel at (714) 203-4576, or Jim Callian at (619) 532-0952.
