FIVE-YEAR REVIEW  
OPERABLE UNIT 1, NORTH GRINDER LANDFILL  
FORMER NAVAL TRAINING CENTER  
ORLANDO, FLORIDA**

The Department of the Navy, Baseline Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Program Management Office (PMO) East is announcing the completion of the third Five-Year Review of the remedial actions at the former North Grinder Landfill, Operable Unit (OU) 1, located on the former Naval Training Center (NTC) Orlando, FL. The purpose of the Five-Year Review was to evaluate the performance of the remedy and to verify that the remedy remains protective of human health and the environment. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) approved the findings of the Five-Year Review in September 2015. The Five-Year review was completed in March 2016.
