The Department of the Navy, in coordination with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, encourages the public to comment on the Proposed Plan for Installation Restoration Site 22A at the former Naval Weapons Station Seal Beach Detachment Concord (NAVWPNSTA) in Concord, California.

Site 22A is located within the central portion of the Inland Area of the former NAVWPNSTA Concord. The Proposed Plan presents a summary of investigations as well as the Navy's preferred remedial alternatives of no action at Magazine Groups 1, 2 and 4, and implementation of land use controls at Magazine Groups 3 and 5.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The Navy invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the Proposed Plan during the 45-day public comment period from **November 5, 2012, through December 20, 2012**.
