The U.S. Navy, in coordination with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, is announcing the public availability of the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) to support a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) removal action at Site 1, NAWC - Trenton, West Trenton, New Jersey. The Navy has identified a failed storm sewer pipe and surrounding soil contaminated with trichloroethylene. This condition was identified during investigations to identify and mitigate locations of groundwater infiltration into the storm sewer system at the former facility. The work will be located on the western end of the facility, north of Parkway Avenue on property currently owned by Nassimi N&H Realty. The EE/CA evaluates three alternatives to mitigate the failed pipe and contaminated soil.

The Navy favors Alternative 3, Excavation and Off-Site Disposal, but would like the public's opinion. Once public comments are received and considered, the Navy will select and implement an alternative, or a modified alternative, and publish the decision in an Action Memorandum that will also be made available to the public.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The Navy will accept comments on the EE/CA during the 30-day public comment period held from December 4, 2014 through January 3, 2015. Public comments must be submitted in writing and postmarked or emailed no later than January 3, 2015.
